### Preparation of technical and financial Review

(1) Experience with technical Reviews:

- key issues on financials (statistics) and allocation of work
- no questions on actual deliverables (technical aspects)

- EuropeanaLocal strong focus on deliverables
- external reviewers for deliverables  $\rightarrow$  follow up questions during review

### STERNA [P. Mergen]

- same desk officer (M. Watelet)
- discussion on results and deliverables

### (2) Open Questions for Technical Review of BHL-Europe

- external review of deliverables
- financial issue: 70% rule
- submission deadline for financial statement
  - o within 30 days of the first anniversary?
  - end of reporting period = end of first year? (30<sup>th</sup> April)
  - collection of financial statements: 1<sup>st</sup> of May? (ask M. Watelet)
- documents for financial audit necessary? (ask M. Watelet) 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment expected not before 2<sup>nd</sup> of September

### (3) Recommendations for review:

- project presentation before upcoming questions
- presence of all partners (representatives)
- deliverables in time (6 deliverables by end of April!)
- review document:
  - o short
  - one month before review?
  - progress report, review document or form? (ask M. Watelet)

#### (4) Review Meeting (May, Vienna)

- internal review of work package by each project managers
- preparation of one presentation per work package (spot risk and issues and its solutions)
- Review Meeting duration: 3 days
  - o 25<sup>th</sup> of May:
    - review of presentation for meeting (PMG)
    - produce consistent set of presentation
  - o 27<sup>th</sup> of May: Review Meeting
  - o 26<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> of May: Workshops

### **No-cost extension of BHL-Europe**

- long term approach (preparations will start this year)
- technical arguments:
  - o continuation of data uploading after funding period
  - o project provides framework, but ingest takes longer
  - o raise public awareness
  - o parallel BHL-Europe with Europeana, further adaptations necessary (end date 2014)
  - o M. Watelets personal opinion for reasonable approach (ask in Vienna)

## **BHL-Europe planning**

#### First ideas for BHL-Europe business plan

- annual report public report → business plan included in progress report (D1.2)
- business plan two pillars:
  - o NHM: hardware, maintenance of technical structure
  - o MfN: maintenance of structural framework (organisation), networks; public awareness [internal negotiation]
- EDIT / CETAF secretariat (coordination office)
  - NHM, NAT, RBINS, MNHN, MfN may contribute to support secretariat after funding period
  - o negotiation in process (June meeting) [update from C. Häuser]
  - o BHL-Europe to participate?

### **Summer Meeting BHL-Europe (date, location)**

- joint technical meeting BHL-Europe with global partners (US, Australia, China)
  - o 3-5 attendants expected per partner (Australia, China, US)
  - o discussion on technical aspects
- BHL-Europe PMG contractual meeting as side meeting (add. work group meetings)
- location: UK- NHM London
- dates:
  - o 5th of July BHL-Europe: PMG Meeting and technical meeting
  - o 6<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> of July BHL Global [Jiri absent]

### Management and presentation of BnF content BHL-Europe

- French Ministry of Culture: no commercial reuse of public content (new law)
- options:
  - o avoid commercial use of BnF content, redirection of links? → against definition of public domain!
  - o stop ingest of BnF content, define new MoUs?
  - o BnF has to solve this problem (contract with same phrasing already signed)
- problems:
  - o multiple versions of public domain (unmanageable in global scale)
  - o BnF provides: 300dpi images, view images, no download allowed
- PMG agreement: no change of contract/ MoU
  - o BnF/France has to find a proper solution for all related partner projects
  - o Europeana and BHL-Europe joint approach (alignment)
