 - Collection Policy
 - This also means that every author has to check his/her chapter(s)
 - Every author shall re-write his/her chapter consider: Document "How to write the BPG" General things Wiki/Document "Instructions re-writing chapters for the BPG" Document "BHL-E_D2pt9_BPG_hints" chapter specific – additional comments can be added
 - Second when first is finished: every author shall mark the most important text passages in his/her chapter and send the affected chapters (re-written and important text passages marked) to <u>m.hierschlaeger@landesmuseum.at</u>
