How to get here

National Museum

New building (north of the old museum building - socilalistic architecture)

In the map below the route from the hotel Falkensteiner to the new building of the museum is doted in red.





Public transport:

The museum building is situated in the south end of the Vaclavske namesti square in the city of Prague.

The best connection is by underground (Metro).

Metro line A and C station MUZEUM (crossing of lines A and C). Fares: A single trip ticket is 26 CZK (Kč).

Trams and buses do not have stops at the museum.

Coming from the airport:

Transport from the airport is possible by taxi or bus.

By taxi: Taxi fares are approximately 650 CZK / 25 EUR to the city (National Museum). By bus: No. 119 goes to the Dejvicka Metro station. The journey is described in detail in the following website. http://www.ruzyneletiste.cz/mhd-letiste-praha.htm

By train:

International intercity trains stop in the Main Railway Station, which is one stop by Metro line C (direction Haje) from the National Museum.

By car:

There is a large street in front of and behind the museum building (direction Brno – Dresden see the map). The entrance for cars is in northern gate of the museum (old building) or southern gate of the new building (former socialistic parliament building). If you decide to come by car, please contact us in advance, we need to reserve a parking place for you.
