



## Directions to the Natural History Museum

Address: Natural History Museum (NHM), Cromwell Road, London SW7 5BD

For the BHL scheduled meetings and tours go to the **EXHIBITION ROAD staff entrance**. The reception team and Library staff will sign you in and take you to the meeting room or tour.



### General Directions for getting to South Kensington.

The nearest Tube station is South Kensington on the District, Piccadilly and Circle lines. The station is approximately five minutes' walk from the Museum.

Use the [Transport for London Journey Planner \(www.tfl.gov.uk\)](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) to find the quickest route to the Museum. **By bus** : Routes 14, 49, 70, 74, 345, 360, 414, 430 and C1 stop close to the Museum.

From Heathrow Airport to South Kensington: Take the [Heathrow Express www.heathrowexpress.com](http://www.heathrowexpress.com) to Paddington Station and then the Underground to South Kensington

OR Take the [Underground from Heathrow http://www.heathrow.com/transport-and-directions/underground](http://www.heathrow.com/transport-and-directions/underground) direct to South Kensington.

**Public Opening Times:** The Museum is open to the public are from 10.00 am to 5.50 pm. The Science Museum and Victoria and Albert Museum (of art and design) are close by and open at similar times. If you have time they are worth a visit. All three have cafes and restaurants.
