- CF: Australia and China have the ability to scan more recent content (up to 1955 Au, China, 1950)
- LK: Participate and data sharing with China and Australia; we should have an agreement with them, in Global BHL. CF, GH: good point, should be fulfilled very soon.
- New project ideas: PM, Students & schools could be involved in the projects, included in educational projects;
- Helpdesk: Tom, Antonio, Tine agreed to test. More are invited to participate.

Pre-Ingest:

- Christian: one xls file for a bunch of pdf, how to process – Chris to talk to Wolfgang.
- Christian: different languages in the corpus, multiple languages in one document – language code in metadata, interesting challenge for OCR
- Judith: OCR from CP? – no problem, happy to take it; we also make coordinates and need that to add if CP provide it

Portal:

- Patricia: diacritics stripped out – reason is manual ingest
- Chris: tips and tricks to avoid before release, no standalone bookviewer, read useability test (BHL-Au vs. BHL-US)
- Michaela: what if pdf delivered with OCR, still separate delivery of pdf and PCR? – bookviewer show images, currently pdf generated out of images
- Pat: content provider will be there? Yes.
- Chris: CP for US – scanning library
- Pat: Europeana API embedded? – not yet; API does some things we need to do, we may enhance it for our purpose
- Francisco: ToC in the bookviewer, like in BHLUS? – bookviewer in the design frame, then ToC can be added
- Francisco: short title, like Nature, how to narrow down – facet list in BHLE to narrow down to journal
- Lee: how to let people know it is part of a global BHL product

GRIB:

- Origins view – Graham ask if this is editable – yes, but better update the catalogue
- Michaela: only editing own data (digitisation status)? – yes
- Michaela: account for non contributing libraries? – no
- Boris: library catalogue updates and testing from January
- Chris: BHLUS digitised included, not yet
- Judith: journal holdings – run ZDB against GRIB; related publications show holdings of other providers
- Larissa: how to recognise it is a duplicate or not – if no match, on new record; different holding show duplicates
- Michaela: is it possible to manually deduplicate – yes, but not the common use case; 2 ways using the GRIB, 1) use it as digitisation management tool, 2) manipulate data
- Michaela: manual data import – not yet available
