Target users are libraries First introduction

mini – for director

midi – for librarians and scientist

spee – those who are actually working with it

mini very short overview what digitisation may mean in the digitisation domain

spee – running practice, should we involve taxonomic metadata

midi – expect to read starting paragraph – something about content profile technical

infrastructure – architecture, IPR how do you deal with IPR what license are we using BHL

global, Europeana

at the end of each paragraph benefits for new content providers – more visible max2-4 sentences potential benefit. E.g. for the workflow what is your benefit if you are doing that and that.

Talk also about the community

Midi – general summary of spee – enough details to be able to work with it

Mini between dissemination and CP – general interest

Spee reference document for the people who do the digitisation
